In this regard, our client upon consultation and in agreement with Big Sea Trading LLC makes the following revised terms for your kind consideration.

1. The proposed settlement amount of the Ghana Cedi equivalent of Two Million Euros (€2,000,000) will be paid in two equal instalments as follows:

- i. One million Euros (€1,000,000) on the execution of a Settlement Agreement.
- ii. One Million Euros (€1,000,000) within Six (6) months of the execution of the Settlement Agreement.

2. Save as varied in (1) above, the remaining terms of the original proposal remain the same i.e

- i. The Government of the Republic of Ghana will release the thirty (30) ambulances in their current state together with all the accessories originally consigned to Government and supplied by Big Sea Trading LLC.
- ii. The Government of the Republic of Ghana will unreservedly discontinue Case No. **CR/0198/2022** against all Accused Persons upon the execution of the Settlement Agreement and receipt of final payment.

We trust that your office will find the above revised terms acceptable.

Our client looks forward to hearing favourably from you.
